



DATA PROTECTION IMPACT ASSESSMENT (DPIA) (APPENDIX)

The data protection impact assessment must be enclosed with the research permit application. The form is required if special categories of personal data are processed in the project. The purpose of the data protection impact assessment is to identify and manage risks relating to the processing of personal data. The assessment should be carried out from the point of view of data subjects, i.e. it should assess:

- what freedoms or rights of data subjects could be impacted by the processing of their data
- what damage could be caused to data subjects by the planned processing of personal data. Damage can be physical, material or non-material.

From where will data be obtained or collected? Where will the data be stored?

2. PLEASE ASSESS THE NECESSITY AND PROPORTIONALITY OF THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

Why are personal data needed in the research project? How do you justify their use?

3. PLEASE ASSESS THE RISKS RELATING TO THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

Assess risks from the point of view of data subjects.

4. PLEASE DESCRIBE WHAT MEASURES WILL BE TAKEN TO MITIGATE THE RISKS

Eg. data anonymisation and pseudonymisation, addressing data security risks in data storage and disposal, etc.
