It's about doing the right thing when we speak, write, listen, or convey messages—being respectful, honest, fair, and responsible in all our interactions.

Purpose and contents of the course

This BIP offers an engaging international learning experience focused on communication ethics in diverse professional contexts. Participants will explore how ethical principles influence communication practices, with particular attention to empathy, leadership, intercultural understanding, and inclusivity. Through lectures, group work, interactive sessions, and student-led presentations, participants will gain insights into communication in professional roles, supported decision-making, antiracist practices, and mindfulness, all while fostering international collaboration and reflection.
