IMMIGRANT WOMEN IN EDUCATION AND WORKING LIFE IN SATAKUNTA

PROJECT OBJECTIVE

The project strengthens the integration, study and work readiness, and language skills of women from third countries. The project offers language and digital skills training, information sessions, guidance services and visits.

Together with organizational actors the multicultural competence which is supporting employment is strengthened.

PROJECT TRAINING COURSES

- > The project offers training to strengthen the Finnish language skills and digital skills. The training courses are mainly organized in Kankaanpää and Pori.
- > Individual guidance supports the development of the individual to find their own study or employment path.
- > The project organizes visits to educational institutions and workplaces.

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WORK LIFE INFORMATION EVENTS AND VISITS

The project organizes information events about Finnish working life from a female perspective. Visits to workplaces and educational institutions are arranged based on the interests of participants.

INDIVIDUAL GUIDANCE

Individual guidance maps the skills and dreams for the future of an individual participant. A realistic plan for the path to education and working life is made. Assistance is provided in finding information about different options and applying for education or jobs. Guidance is given on writing applications and CVs and preparing for interviews.

CO-DEVELOPMENT WITH ORGANIZATIONS

Workshops are organized to jointly develop activities of the organisations that support employment.

+ MAPPING SKILLS AND DREAMS FOR THE FUTURE

TRAINING FOR ORGANIZATION VOLUNTEERS

Themes include strengthening the employment and functional capacity of women, as well as skills of multicultural encountering as part of organizational activities.

Training course themes:

1. language awareness and linguistic accessibility
2. respectful encounter and interaction
3. supporting Finnish language learning, and
4. intercultural communication.
